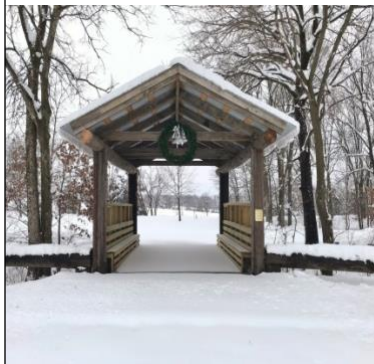
We dreamed of having this bridge our church property!

1. **Jesus is your Bridge.** When you recognize that you are a sinner in need of the Savior. He, alone, is the Mediator who can GIVE you a right relationship with our Heavenly Father. The New Testament calls this "the gift of righteousness." We learn how to build THIS NEW LIFE on right relationship.
2. **Love will build a bridge.** Jesus teaches us how to BRIDGE relationships with others. He calls us to reconcile breaches caused by all things divisive and offensive. Some of the divides are religious, racial, or political. But we can all do better at building relationships with God's people.

3. **Our pilgrimage together over the Bridge is a journey of faith and victory.** We come together as one for the King and His Kingdom. All of us have temptation, testing and trials. But together we find grace even through painful imperfections, addictions, and very real personal conflicts. Despite all of this, the gift of righteousness is real and the ministry of reconciliation works. We believe it is important to journey together as the congregation of the Lord! (*Psalms 85:10 and 84:5-7; 2 Samuel 5*)
